

As in the January meeting, there will be a small table with name tags available (and encouraged) to help us get to know each other better. For those who enjoy arriving early, please feel free to get your name tags and visit in the vestibule outside of the meeting room until the check-in team gives the go ahead.

Where the vestibule opens into the meeting room, there will be two entrance lines - one on each end of the long table. Signs will be posted to indicate which is which.

One line will check in **Annual Members** and will accept no money.

One side will check in **Regular Members**, **New Applicants**, and **Guests** and will be accepting appropriate fees and necessary paperwork.

Reminder: Membership and entrance fees increased effective Feb 1st. Also, as an FYI, in keeping with CFSC's long-standing by laws, all who join after January 31st are considered "New Members."

Regular Member and Guest check-in fee at each meeting - \$15
